Jordan River Baptism

November 8 - DEPART USA

Today we meet at our international departure airport where our host will assist with check-in formalities. This evening we will enjoy a delicious dinner high above the Atlantic.

November 9 - ARRIVE TEL AVIV – TIBERIAS

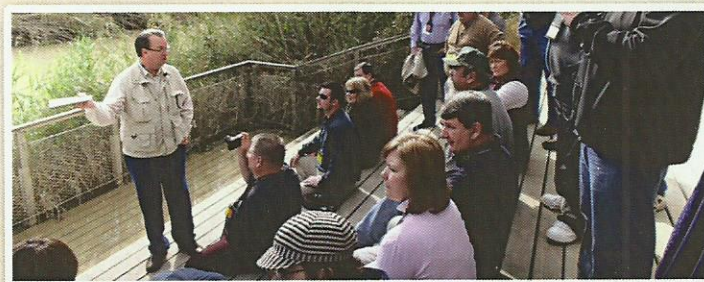
Welcome Home -- to the Land of the Bible! We arrive in Tel Aviv early this afternoon. Upon arrival, we will be met by our TEMPLETON TOURS representative who will assist us through customs. After airport procedures have been completed, we will meet our local guide and drive straight to Tiberias on the Sea of Galilee. Jesus spent His entire ministry in this area and performed many of His miracles here. Tonight we will have our first meal together on the shores of the Galilee. (D)

November 10 - TIBERIAS – SEA OF GALILEE – CAESAREA PHILIPPI – JORDAN RIVER

After breakfast we will depart the hotel at 10 am for a journey across the Sea of Galilee on a wooden "Jesus boat". While on the Sea we will stop the boat and have a special service together. We will continue on to En-Gev for our lunch where you will have the option of enjoying local St. Peters fish. From here we travel north through the Hula Valley to (Banias) or Caesarea Philipi (Matthew 16). Here we will have a demonstrated Bible lesson that will make this passage literally come alive. Following a short ride through the Golan, we end the day on the banks of the Jordan River for a special Baptismal service. Dinner and overnight at the hotel. (B/L/D)

November 11 - TIBERIAS - CAPERNAUM – NAZARETH – MEGGIDO - CANA - MAGDALA

After breakfast we will get an early start and visit Capernaum, the hometown of Jesus, to see the remains of Peter's house and the ancient synagogue. We will have a short service together on the shores of Galilee, before heading west to Nazareth. There we will visit the "Nazareth Village" to experience life as it was 2,000 years ago. After lunch we will visit "the brow of the hill" (Luke 4:29). This is the location, overlooking the Jezreel Valley, where they intended to throw Jesus down the cliff. From here we will travel across the Valley of Armageddon to the ancient Tel Megiddo. On our journey back to Tiberias we will pass through the village of Cana. We will finish the day at

Magdala, home of Mary Magdalene where you will see the remains of a recently discovered first century church and surrounding village. There we will have a service, as the sun sets over the Sea of Galilee, in a beautiful new church. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias. (B/L/D)

November 12 - TIBERIAS – JORDAN VALLEY - BEIT SHE'AN - BETHABARA - QUMRAN - DEAD SEA

After breakfast we say goodbye to the Sea of Galilee, but take memories that will last a lifetime. We will begin our slow descent through the most fertile valley in all the world, the "Jordan Valley". Here you will see your Bible come alive as the desert is blooming as a rose. This valley produces four crops per year, and as God's Word said in Amos 9:13, "the plowman shall overtake the reaper". His word is always true! We arrive at the world-class archaeological site of Beit She'an next. This is where the Philistines hung the bodies of King Saul and his son Jonathan. As we continue down the Jordan Valley we will stop for a snack. We recommend ice cream, its the best in the world. Next we stop at Bethabara, where John baptized Jesus. This is also known as the "place of the crossing" where the children of Israel entered the Promised Land. From here you are literally a few feet from the country of Jordan, separated only by the Jordan River. Our buses will then take us to the Oasis of Qumran for lunch and an opportunity to view the caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. Then it is on to our beautiful resort hotel on the Dead Sea for dinner and overnight. (B/L/D)

November 13 - MASADA - DEAD SEA

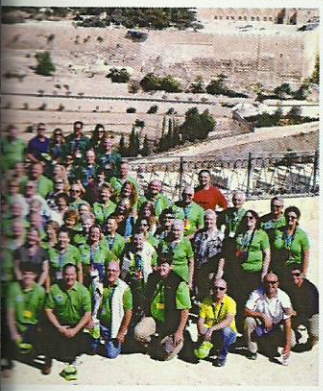
After breakfast we will travel to Masada. Along the way we will stop along the side of the road for our Sunday morning Sunday school lesson under an Achia tree. I promise this will be a lesson you will never forget. Once we've reached the mountain fortress of Masada, a truly remarkable place, we will ascend the top of the mountain by cable car. There you walk over the same exact ground where Jewish zealots lived on and made their last stand against the Roman Army. What a view to the East; the Mountains of Moab, the country of Jordan, and the Dead Sea below. You are at the lowest point on the face of the earth, over 1,300 feet below sea level. We will enjoy a lunch together on the shores of the Dead Sea. Then back to the hotel for an afternoon of free time. You can have a treatment at the spa or enjoy a float in the Dead Sea. Because the salt content is over 25% you cannot swim, but you can literally sit down and float as if in a chair. This is awesome! Do not miss it. Dinner and overnight at the hotel. (B/L/D)

November 14 - DEAD SEA - EIN GEDI - VALLEY OF THE SHADOW - JERUSALEM

Every day just gets better. We will leave the desert behind and begin our journey up to Jerusalem. Along the way we will pass by Ein Gedi where David hid while fleeing from King Saul. We will travel the Jericho Road heading up to Jerusalem. Along the way we'll pass the traditional site of the Good Samaritan Inn. Our bus will exit the main highway and take us along a winding road to "the Valley of the Shadow of Death". You will view the same valley King David used along with others to move from the desert oasis of Jericho up to the high pasture with his sheep for summer grazing. Psalms 23 was literally written from the experience of this valley. You are here, God has brought you to this valley. How great and mighty is the Word of our God. The promise God made David, he made to us as we walk "through" the valley. Amen! As we continue up to Jerusalem keep a look out on both sides of the road where you will see "Bedouins" living as they have for centuries, with their sheep and goats. On the mountains you will see the sheep trails 4-6 inches wide that are still traveled today. Feel the anticipation we are almost there, the City of Jerusalem (God's city) is just ahead. You will view the

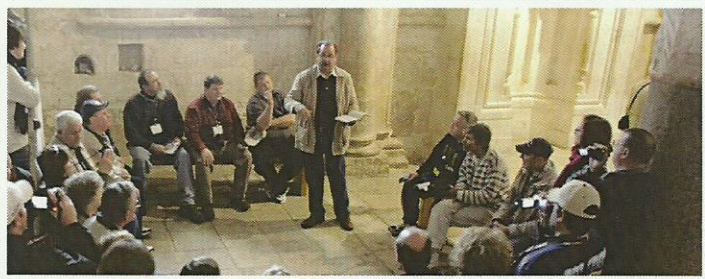

Old City from the bus window as we drive to the Mount of Olives for our traditional Welcome to Jerusalem. Then we will go into the area of the Western Wall via the "Dung Gate". Here you will have the time to walk down to The Wall and pray along side Jews and other pilgrims from all over the world. This afternoon we visit the "Temple Treasure Institute" where the implements are stored that will be used in the worship in the Third Temple. We will check into our hotel for dinner and overnight. (B/L/D)

November 15 - TEMPLE MOUNT - EASTERN GATE - POOL OF BETHESDA - SOUTHERN WALL EXCAVATIONS - YAD V'SHEM

After breakfast we return to the Dung Gate and if conditions permit, we will visit the Temple Mount. It is here where the First and Second Temple stood and where the Third Temple will be built. This is also Mount Moriah where Abraham was to offer up Isaac. We will then visit the Eastern Gate, and continue on through the Old City to the Crusader church dedicated to St. Anne and see the Pools of Bethesda. We will walk the streets that will lead us to the Southern Steps, the same steps Jesus would have walked when entering the Second Temple. This afternoon you will experience the museum of "Yad V'Shem", built to honor the six million Jews who died during the Holocaust. You will

enter a room where the names of the 1.5 million children who died are spoken 24 hours a day, never stopping. This is an experience that you will long remember, what a way to end this day. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem. (B/L/D)

November 16 - WESTERN WALL TUNNEL - PILATE'S PALACE - UPPER ROOM - TOMB OF KING DAVID - JEWISH QUARTER - MOUNT OF OLIVES

After breakfast we visit the Western Wall Tunnel. Here you will see and touch the actual stones laid by the workers of King Herod. Our next stop will be the Antonia fortress, site of Pilate's Palace. We will pass many of the traditional Stations of the Cross on the Via Dolorosa as walk through the old market place. We will visit the Roman Cardo in the restored Jewish Quarter, the main street of Jerusalem during Roman times. We will then proceed to Mt. Zion and the traditional Upper Room. We will also visit the traditional site of King David's tomb. After lunch we will have time for shopping. This will give you an opportunity to pick up items for loved ones or yourself. We will finish our day on the Mt. of Olives and watch the sun go down over Jerusalem. Back to hotel for dinner and overnight. (B/L/D)

November 17 - GETHSEMANE - HOUSE OF CAIAPHAS - CALVARY - GARDEN TOMB - TEL AVIV

Today is our last day in the Holy Land, but one you will never forget. After breakfast we enter the Garden of Gethsemane, where you will see and be within a few feet of the same trees where Jesus prayed. We will pause here for a private time of devotion and prayer in The Garden, where you can pray under your own olive tree. Next we will walk through the Kidron Valley, and pass the traditional tombs of Absalom and Ezra. At the end of the valley we come to the Pool of Siloam, where Jesus healed the blind man. Next we visit a very special place the "House of Caiaphas". This is the probable location where our Lord spent his night in the pit. You too will be in a pit like Jesus was placed in. Following a wonderful lunch together we will end our tour with a visit to the Garden Tomb. There you will see and enter the "Empty" Tomb and enjoy a time of communion. You will have time to relax and prepare for the return flight home before dinner at the hotel. (B/L/D)

November 18- ARRIVE USA

We arrive back in the USA this morning with memories that will last a lifetime.

DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS: A deposit of \$250.00 per person is required to reserve space on the tour. An additional payment of \$750.00 per person is due July 31, 2016. The final payment is due no less than 60 days prior to the departure date of the tour (September 9, 2016). Payment can be made by personal check or money order.
